i. Number of Students Benefited from Skill Development and Self-Employment Training Modules

The institution has made consistent efforts to enhance the employability and entrepreneurial capabilities of students through the organization of various skill development and self-employment-oriented sessions. These initiatives aim to provide practical exposure, career guidance, and awareness about diverse professional opportunities.

During the assessment period, a series of expert lectures and training sessions were conducted by distinguished professionals from administrative, academic, banking, and defense sectors. These sessions significantly contributed to the holistic development of students by equipping them with essential skills, knowledge, and motivation.

A lecture by Sh. Praveen Pundir (DSP) benefitted 50 students, focusing on career opportunities in the police services and the importance of discipline and dedication. Mr. Rajesh Negi (BDO, Tilordhar) addressed 47 students, emphasizing rural development, government schemes, and opportunities in public

administration. Similarly, Dr. Jagdish Chauhan, Principal of SGGSJ Government College, Paonta Sahib, delivered an insightful session attended by 47 students, guiding them on academic excellence and career planning.

Further, Mr. Balbir Sharma (EA, HP State Co-operative Bank, Kaffota) conducted a session attended by 70 students, focusing on financial literacy, banking awareness, and the role of financial management in self-employment. Additionally, COL. Rajeev Sharma (1HP (I) COY NCC, Nahan) addressed 50 students, motivating them towards discipline, leadership, and career opportunities in the armed forces.

Although the cumulative participation across all sessions was recorded as 264, it includes repeated participation by some students in multiple sessions. The actual number of unique beneficiaries was 121 out of the total enrolled strength of 181 students. This indicates that approximately 66.85% of students benefitted from these skill development and self-employment training modules.
