Government College Shillai and Government Degree College Kaffota therefore agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in the areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).


**A. Objectives**

The goal is to foster collaboration, provide opportunity for experience, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions. Government College Shillai and Government Degree College Kaffota agree:

## **B. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting**

Government College Shillai and Government Degree College Kaffota agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institutions to participate in research and development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement.

## **C. Exchange of Faculty and Staff**

Government College Shillai and Government Degree College Kaffota agree to encourage collaboration between faculty and staff from the two institutions. Specifically, institutions will encourage members of their faculties to undertake short visits to, or take up fixed-term visiting assignments at, each other's institutions. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning stipend, travel, name of the concerned faculty members will be worked out mutually by both the institutions.

Notwithstanding the above, both the institutions will examine ways to identify financial resources to fund the activities for their faculty and staff.

## **D. Student Exchange**

Government College Shillai and Government Degree College Kaffota agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

1. Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
2. An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
3. An exchange student will be considered full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.
4. His/her programme of study at host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor or mentor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
5. The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
6. If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
7. Both the institutions agree to provide suitable accommodation and living expenses for student exchange in accordance with the rules and regulations governing these institutions.

8. To avail travel expenses, the students can apply for existing funding programs at their respective home institutions.
9. The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

### **E. Exchange of Research and Educational Material**


Government College Shillai and Government Degree College Kaffota will exchange information on research and educational programmes and teaching/learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes. Further, both institutions agree to explore ways to share teaching/learning material, and other relevant literature, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

### **F. Joint Seminars, Conferences, Workshops and Short-Term Courses**

Government College Shillai and Government Degree College Kaffota agree to help identify and invite faculty members from other institutions to participate in seminars, conferences, workshops, and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between both the institutions.


### **G. Intellectual Property**

Government College Shillai and Government Degree College Kaffota agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

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
